Schwannoma of the brachial plexus :A case Report

Abstract:

Brachial plexus tumours are rather rare peripheral nerve tumours. Schwannoma, the most common benign PNST, arises from the Schwann cell. Management of tumors of the brachial plexus region requires a complete understanding of the anatomy and the commonly seen anatomic variations encountered at surgery.

We report one case of schwannoma presenting as right shoulder mass for half year and right hand numbness for several months. Good prognosis without post-operative neural deficits was found. With appropriate perioperative and intraoperative management, neurologic deficits from brachial plexus tumor surgery can be minimized.
