Fascia Lata Sling Commissure Plasty for An Advanced Buccal Cancer Patient– Case Report

purpose:

Reconstruction of the oral commissure is purposed to form lip symmetry and oral competence. It is a difficult task to restore lip commissure with functional and cosmetic fidelity

Case presentation:

A 56-year-old male patient is a case of advanced buccal cancer underwent wide excision with ALT free flap reconstruction 2 years ago. He complained of left drooling from oral commissure. The patient underwent fascia lata sling suspension for commissure plasty. The postoperative course was uneventful and symptoms improved with appropriate oral competence.

Conclusion:

Oral commissure can be reconstructed with fascia lata sling for suspension. This reconstructive strategy can be applied to advanced buccal cancer patient status post free flap reconstruction and complained of lip asymmetry or oral incompetence.
